1. Name & address. You should reside in the counties of Southwest England.
2. Date of Birth. You should be over 18 yrs old and not older than 35 years old by 1st November 2023.
3. Your association with the Royal Bath and West Show or the Society.
4. How this experience will help your future education or career.
5. How this experience will help you support the Royal Bath & West Show in the Future.
6. Please confirm how you will meet the shortfall between the total cost and the bursary.

Your application will be considered by the Society's Charity Committee in November 2023 and if you are successful you will be notified as soon after as possible. The Royal Bath & West of England Society is a charity. Charity No. 1039397.

**Note:** the Society will expect the bursary recipient to take an active role in the Society's work in the future including assisting with the delivery of our charitable objectives encompassing education and supporting the rural economy. It is expected that the recipient will write an article for the Society's annual Journal and deliver a presentation to our Council.
